CU PERKS

Discounts and Dining

- All Cameron employees and members of their immediate family receive free admission to all CU athletic events, as well as reduced prices to campus concerts and plays.
- Employees also receive a 10 percent discount on all items at the Cameron bookstore and online at EFollett.com.
- Employees enjoy an 8.5 percent discount on all food items purchased with their Cam Card, and receive discounted meals at the Shepler Dining Hall every Friday.
- Cameron employees are also eligible for a variety of discounts from community businesses by simply presenting your Cameron ID card. - In addition, CU employees receive a 15 percent service discount from AT&T Wireless.

Reserved Parking

A permit for reserved parking will be issued without charge to full-time and part-time faculty, staff, teaching assistants and adjunct faculty. You may register up to two vehicles on this permit at no charge.

Tuition Waiver

All benefited full time and part time employees are eligible for a tuition waiver in both undergraduate and graduate courses offered by Cameron. For full time

employees the waiver is available for up to six hours in each of the fall and spring semesters and up to three hours each summer. Three-quarter time and part-time employees' tuition waiver is prorated to match their employment status.

Fitness Center

All employees and members of their immediate family may utilize the fitness center, which offers the following amenities and activities: swimming pool; indoor track; racquetball, basketball and badminton courts; and cardio, weight training, and aerobics areas. In addition, a variety of free aerobics classes are offered Monday through Friday. The fitness center also includes a faculty/staff locker room complete with showers, and provides sports equipment and towels.

Training and Development

An investment in our employees learning environment is important to the organization's success. With that in mind, we have an online learning system, *Aggie Click to Learn* that provides both mandatory compliance training depending upon your position and optional career development courses in a variety of topics.
